

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES

It is the intent of the Doniphan-Trumbull Board of Education that potential areas of conflict and equitable solutions to problems which may arise affecting the terms and working conditions of qualified individuals with disabilities be resolved consistent with the goal to maintain high staff morale and increased effectiveness of employees.

The Board directs the Superintendent of Schools to establish and make available to employees a procedure for filing alleged violations by the Doniphan-Trumbull Public School of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.
