Will put on the web to sell around the 15<sup>th</sup> of November. We will set up a booth to sell clothing tomorrow night at the volleyball game. Brenda will set it up and sell. Second order will be due December 1<sup>st</sup>, with the order to go out the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup>.
